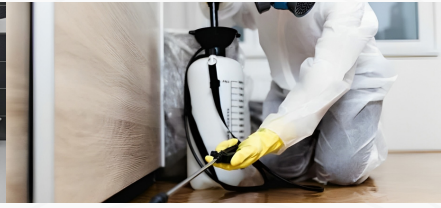
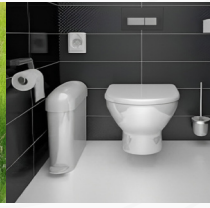
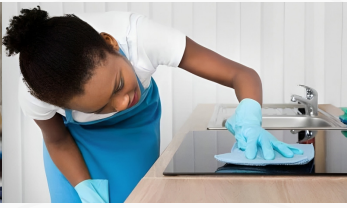
## Dan Kimeu's Hobby

Dan started engaging in writing articles and editing other people's scholarly works for both undergraduates and post graduate students for the last six years. He says he has inculcated competencies in editorial work that goes beyond the undergraduate projects to Thesis of post graduates students. He stated doing this during his under graduate studies. To date he has created a big network with both Kenyan and foreign university students. So far he is working with over 10 students from Kenyan universities including three from University of Nairobi and hundreds from Universities and colleges in United States of America. He does this by engaging his clients through online platforms. The services offered include mentoring, coaching and editing manuscripts. In the current year, Dan is working with 15 students from Florida State University and Lama University He also engages in academic writing, a practice that is coming up in Kenya among college and university students. In line with MUST curriculum development policy, where all stake holders and partners are engaged, our alumni are not left behind in many fronts. The innovative methods of teaching and technology transfer during curricula delivery enables our graduates to tackle the health challenges of the 21st century, in a World of diminishing resources and full of challenges.

Mr. Martin Mukundi Njagi, a 2017 BSc. Public Health graduate defines Public Health for us as:

"Public Health refers to all organized measures (whether public or private) to prevent diseases, promote health, and

prolong life among the population as a whole." Mr. Njagi has innovated from WHO's definition of Public Health to not only keep himself afloat amidst hostile employment environment, but to also employ others. "I realized we learn a lot in the university, but put very little of what we learn to use," he said. "Out there, people still require all manner of services which new graduates can offer at a pay and live comfortably," he added.

Before being absorbed by Mombasa County Government where he now works as a Public Health Officer, Mr. Njagi registered a company by the name Mariek Consultant Company. He harnessed the knowledge gained during his degree course to initially advise the members of the community on how to deal with disease vectors such as mosquitoes, cockroaches, bedbugs, houseflies and rats for free. As time went by, he thought of charging some little fees which his clients accepted. "More people approached me after being referred to me by others," says Mr. Njagi. This venture kept Mr. Njagi stable though not comfortable as he continued searching for employment.

With time, Mr. Njagi employed another three people to operate in Meru, Chuka and Embu. The activities they carry out include controlling rats, fumigation and indoor spraying using pyrethrins. He also advises community members on on-site liquid and solid wastes management and installation of water storage facilities. "I was hesitant to leave my company for regular employment, but still left for employment after consultation," he said.

Mr. Njagi thanks the MUST faculty that comprise of experienced Professors, lecturers and Laboratory Technicians, for the good work they do.
